

CETA TOURS LUGGAGE REQUIREMENTS

The following luggage guidelines outline restrictions you should be aware of as imposed by the airline you are flying on, the US Transportation Security Administration (TSA) and CETA Tours. As the traveler, it is **your responsibility** to visit the websites above to obtain the most up to date and specific information. Any luggage fees incurred on tour are the responsibility of the traveler.

CARRY-ON LUGGAGE GUIDELINES:

- CETA Tours does not allow rolling suitcases to be used as carry-on bags, due to space limitations on bus transportation. Rolling carry-on suitcases do not fit under bus seats or in the overhead compartment of the bus.
- Airlines allow each passenger ONE piece of carry-on luggage plus ONE personal item such as a purse or camera bag.
- Visit the website of your airline(s) for up-to-date information on the **size** and **weight** allowance for carry-on luggage. Restrictions vary by airline.
- The TSA restricts or prohibits some items in carry-on luggage, including but not limited to liquids, gels, aerosols & sharp objects. Visit their website for the most current information.

CHECKED LUGGAGE GUIDELINES:

- Visit the website of your airline(s) for the most current information on the **baggage fees** for checked luggage that you will need to pay at the airport. Fees vary by airline.
- Visit the website of your airline(s) for the most current information on the size and weight allowance for checked luggage. Restrictions vary by airline but typically include a maximum of 50 lbs and 62 linear inches (length + width + height).
- CETA Tours allows only ONE piece of checked luggage on tour due to space limitations
 on bus transportation. If you anticipate purchasing many souvenirs on tour, it is
 permissible to bring a collapsible bag in your suitcase and check it as a second bag on
 the return flight only. Expect to pay extra for a second checked bag check with airline
 for details.
- The US Transportation Security Administration (TSA) restricts or prohibits some items in checked luggage. Visit their website for the most current information.
- All checked luggage must be left unlocked to allow TSA and customs to perform checks as efficiently as possible.
- Luggage requires name identification. Prior to your departure, CETA Tours will provide luggage tags printed with your name and address for this purpose.
